Criteria:

- Enrolled in a graduate mental health nursing program in the state of Mississippi
- Official undergraduate and graduate nursing transcripts showing 3.5 GPA
- Current unencumbered license as RN in the state of Mississippi
- Evidence of community service
- Plans to continue community service
- Three letters of recommendation
- Two letters from faculty
- One letter from a person in the community
- The applicant must write a 300-to-350-word essay in APA format (7th edition):
 - "My Role in Impacting Mental Health in my Community"
- **Application and essay submitted by the deadline date – July 8, 2022**

Complete Application Must Include:

- Student information form;
- Essay;
- Letter from school verifying the student is enrolled and in good academic standing;
- Official Transcripts showing GPA of 3.5 or higher.
